THE POSTAL AMENDING REGULATIONS 1955 (NO. 2)

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 24th day of August 1955

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Post and Telegraph Act 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Postal Amending Regulations 1955 (No. 2).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of September 1955.

2. The First Schedule to the Postal Amending Regulations 1952 (No. 2)* is hereby amended by revoking paragraph (b) of Item 1, under the heading "(i) Letters", and substituting the following paragraph:

"(b) By air transport 4d. for the first half oz.;
2d. each additional half oz."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

[This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.]

These regulations effect a reduction in the rates for internal air mail letters. The previous rate was 4d. for each $\frac{1}{2}$ oz.
