At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 19th day of December 1961

PURSUANT to the Post Office Act 1959, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Postal Amending Regulations 1961, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Postal Amending Regulations 1961* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.
- 2. Subclause (1) of regulation 2 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by adding the following proviso:

"Provided that the Postmaster-General may, where multiple postings of one class of postal article take place in circumstances approved by him, permit the payment of reduced rates or charges."
