THE POSTAL AMENDING REGULATIONS 1969

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 31st day of March 1969

THE RIGHT HON. J. R. MARSHALL PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Post Office Act 1959, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Postal Amending Regulations 1969.

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the fourteenth day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. The Postal Amending Regulations (No. 2) 1967* are hereby amended by adding to clause 11 of the First Schedule the following paragraph:

“(h) *Surcharge on parcels by air transport to or from the Chatham Islands:*

Notwithstanding anything in paragraphs (a) to (d) of this clause, for each parcel by air transport to or from the Chatham Islands, a fee of 10c per pound or part thereof shall be payable in addition to the charge for air transport for that parcel as set out in the appropriate paragraph of this clause.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations introduce charges for parcel postage by air transport between the main islands of New Zealand and the Chatham Islands.
