# **PHYSIOTHERAPY AMENDMENT REGULATIONS 1999**

PURSUANT to section 31 of the Physiotherapy Act 1949, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, makes the following regulations.

## REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Physiotherapy Amendment Regulations 1999, and are part of the Physiotherapy Regulations 1979\* ("the principal regulations"). (2) These regulations come into force on 1 April 1999.

2. Fees—(1) Regulation 17 of the principal regulations is amended by revoking subclause (4), and substituting the following subclause:

"(4) The fee payable on an application for registration,-

"(a) Under section 10 (a) of the Act, is \$140.00:

"(b) Under section 10 (b) of the Act, is \$300.00."

(2) Regulation 17 (6) of the principal regulations is amended by omitting the expression "\$110.00", and substituting the expression "\$175.00".

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 April 1999, amend the fees paid by physiotherapists by-

- adding a new fee for an application for registration on the basis of a qualification gained outside New Zealand. (However, a physiotherapist registered in Australia pays, under section 39 (1) of the Trans-Tasman Mutual Recognition Act 1997, the same fee as an applicant who has a New Zealand qualification)
- · increasing the annual practising fee.
