Regulations

1 Title

- (1) These regulations are the Passport (Fees) Amendment Regulations 2001.
- (2) In these regulations, the Passport (Fees) Regulations 1996¹ are called “the principal regulations”.

2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on 3 October 2001.

3 Exemption in respect of urgent travel for death or serious illness

Regulation 7(d) of the principal regulations is amended by omitting the expression “4”, and substituting the expression “5”.

4 Fees

The principal regulations are amended by revoking the Schedule, and substituting the Schedule set out in the Schedule of these regulations.
