THE PAPER (MANUFACTURE AND SALE) CONTROL NOTICE 1942, AMENDMENT NO. 2

Pursuant to the Factory Emergency Regulations 1939, I, George Augustus Pascoe, Factory Controller, hereby direct and give notice as follows:—

- 1. This notice may be cited as the Paper (Manufacture and Sale) Control Notice 1942, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Paper (Manufacture and Sale) Control Notice 1942* (hereinafter referred to as the principal notice).
- 2. This notice shall come into force on the day next following the date of notification hereof in the Gazette.
- 3. Clause 21 of the principal notice (as enacted by clause 10 of the Paper (Manufacture and Sale) Control Notice 1942, Amendment No. 1†, is hereby revoked, and the following clause substituted therefor:—
- "(21) (a) Notwithstanding anything contained in the foregoing provisions of this notice, except with the prior consent in writing of the Factory Controller, no person shall manufacture any school paper stationery coming within the scope of the New Zealand Standard Specification for School Paper Stationery (N.Z.S.S. 362) unless it complies with the provisions of that specification, including any amendment that may hereafter be made:

"Provided that in the case of writing-pads the paper shall not exceed in weight the equivalent of 18 lb. per 500 sheets of a size $16\frac{1}{2}$ in. by 21 in. and shall not be less than the equivalent of 15 lb. per 500 sheets of the same size.

"(b) For the purposes of this clause all books which can reasonably be construed as being capable of use as exercise books for the purposes of primary and post-primary schools, shall be deemed to be exercise books within the meaning of the said specification."
