

THE PAPER (MANUFACTURE AND SALE) CONTROL NOTICE 1942, AMENDMENT NO. 3

PURSUANT to the Factory Emergency Regulations 1939, I, George Augustus Pascoe, Factory Controller, hereby direct and give notice as follows :---

1. This notice may be cited as the Paper (Manufacture and Sale) Control Notice 1942, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Paper (Manufacture and Sale) Control Notice 1942* (hereinafter referred to as the principal notice).

2. This notice shall come into force on the day next following the date of notification thereof in the *Gazette*.

3. Clause 21 of the principal notice (as enacted by clause 3 of the Paper (Manufacture and Sale) Control Notice 1942, Amendment No. 2[†]) is hereby revoked.

4. The Paper (Manufacture and Sale) Control Notice 1942, Amendment No. 2[†] is hereby consequentially revoked.
