**THE POST AND TELEGRAPH (STAFF) REGULATIONS 1925,
AMENDMENT NO. 20**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington, this 10th day of
July, 1946

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Post and Telegraph Act, 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Post and Telegraph (Staff) Regulations 1925, Amendment No. 20.
2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the regulations made under the Post and Telegraph Department Act, 1918, on the 14th day of December, 1925* (hereinafter called the principal regulations), as heretofore amended from time to time.
3. These regulations shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April, 1946.
4. The Post and Telegraph (Staff) Regulations 1925, Amendment No. 12†, and the Post and Telegraph (Staff) Regulations 1925, Amendment No. 19‡, are revoked.
