**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

PURSUANT to the Post and Telegraph Act, 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Post and Telegraph (Staff) Regulations 1925, Amendment No. 26.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and deemed part of the regulations (hereinafter called the principal regulations) made on the 14th day of December, 1925, under the Post and Telegraph Department Act, 1918, and enuring under the Post and Telegraph Act, 1928.

3. These regulations shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April, 1950.

4. The principal regulations, as amended by regulation 4 of the Post and Telegraph (Staff) Regulations 1925, Amendment No. 25, are hereby amended by revoking the First Schedule thereto, and substituting the First Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

5. Regulations 3 and 4 of the Post and Telegraph (Staff) Regulations 1925, Amendment No. 25, are hereby revoked.
