**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government House at Wellington, this 3rd day of September 1952

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE GOVERNMENT IN COUNCIL  
PURSUANT to the Post and Telegraph Act 1928, His Excellency the  
Administrator of the Government, acting by and with the advice and  
consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

**1.** These regulations may be cited as the Post and Telegraph Staff  
Regulations 1951, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with  
and deemed part of the Post and Telegraph Staff Regulations 1951\*  
(hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

**2.** Regulation 12 of the principal regulations is hereby revoked.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*[This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their  
general effect.]*

The effect of the amendment is to remove the requirement that the  
Director-General shall publish annually in the *Gazette* a list of persons permanently  
employed in the Post Office.
