**THE POULTRY BOARD REGULATIONS 1939,
AMENDMENT NO. 1**

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government Buildings at Wellington, this 9th day of
September, 1942.

THE HON. D. G. SULLIVAN PRESIDING IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Poultry-runs Registration Act, 1933, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Poultry Board Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and form part of the Poultry Board Regulations 1939* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).

2. Clause (1) of Regulation 5 of the principal regulations is amended by revoking the expression “£1 1s.”, and substituting therefor the expression “£1 5s.”.

3. Regulation 6 of the principal regulations is amended by adding the following as clause (3) thereof:—

“(3) There may be paid to each member of the Board other than the Chairman, in addition to any other fees, expenses, or allowances which may be paid to such member by the Board, an honorarium in respect of his services at such annual rate as the Board may determine, not exceeding the rate of £12 10s. per annum.”

4. Regulation 7 of the principal regulations is amended by revoking the expression “£350”, and substituting therefor the expression “£450”.

5. Regulation 8 of the principal regulations is amended by adding the following as paragraph “(j)” thereof:—

“(j) In payment of such sum as may from time to time be approved by the Minister in respect of the establishment and maintenance of any organization of poultry-producers in New Zealand and in respect of the expenses incurred in connection with any annual conference of representatives of poultry-producers.”
