HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Poultry-runs Registration Act, 1933, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Poultry Board Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and form part of the Poultry Board Regulations 1939 (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Clause (1) of Regulation 6 of the principal regulations is amended by revoking the expression "£50", and substituting therefor the expression "£100".

3. Clause (3) of Regulation 6 of the principal regulations (as inserted by Regulation 3 of the Poultry Board Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 1) is amended by revoking the expression "£12 10s.", and substituting therefor the expression "£50".
