PURSUANT to the Poultry-runs Registration Act, 1933, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Poultry Board Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and form part of the Poultry Board Regulations 1939* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).

2. Clause (1) of Regulation 5 of the principal regulations (as amended by Regulation 2 of the Poultry Board Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 1) is further amended by revoking the words and figures "in the case of members £1 5s., and in the case of officers and servants 17s. 6d.", and substituting therefor the expression "£1 5s."
