THE POULTRY BOARD REGULATIONS 1939, AMENDMENT NO. 4

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to the Poultry-runs Registration Act, 1933, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Poultry Board Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 4.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Poultry Board Regulations 1939* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- 3. Regulation 4 of the principal regulations is amended by revoking clause (4) thereof, and substituting the following clause:—
- "(4) Where a private motor-car has been used by any member, officer, or servant of the Board in travelling on the business of the Board, the member, officer, or servant shall be entitled to a mileage-allowance computed by the shortest possible practicable route at a rate counted each way not exceeding $5\frac{1}{2}$ d. a mile where the horse-power of the car does not exceed $9\frac{1}{2}$, $6\frac{1}{4}$ d. a mile where the horse-power of the car exceeds $9\frac{1}{2}$ but does not exceed $14\frac{1}{2}$, and $6\frac{3}{4}$ d. a mile where the horse-power of the car exceeds $14\frac{1}{2}$."
