**THE POULTRY BOARD REGULATIONS 1949,
AMENDMENT NO. 1**

Present :

THE HON. S. G. HOLLAND PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Poultry-runs Registration Act, 1933, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Poultry Board Regulations 1949, Amendment No. 1.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and deemed part of the Poultry Board Regulations 1949* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).

3. Regulations 5, 6, 7, and 8 of the principal regulations are hereby revoked, and the following regulation substituted therefor :—

“ 5. (1) The Travelling-allowance Regulations 1949† shall apply to and shall be deemed to be incorporated in these regulations so as to relate to the Board and to officers, servants, and members of the Board.

“ (2) The subsistence allowance referred to in Regulation 5 of the Travelling-allowance Regulations 1949 shall be at the rate of £1 15s. a day :

“ Provided that where a person is entitled to a subsistence allowance pursuant to this regulation and occupies a hotel room for one night only, an additional amount of 2s. may be paid to that person.

“ (3) The mileage allowance referred to in Regulation 13 of the Travelling-allowance Regulations 1949 shall be calculated in accordance with the following table :—

Horse-power of Car.	Mileage Allowance.
Not exceeding 9½	5½d. a mile.
Exceeding 9½ but not exceeding 14½	6¼d. a mile.
Over 14½	7d. a mile.

“(4) Garage expenses payable to any person pursuant to this regulation shall not exceed 2s. 6d. for every night on which any such expenses are incurred.”

4. Regulation 10 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words “£565 per annum”, and substituting the words “£600 per annum.”
