Pursuant to the Poultry Runs Registration Act, 1933, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- These regulations may be cited as the Poultry Board Regulations 1949, Amendment No. 2.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and deemed part of the Poultry Board Regulations 1949* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).
- 3. Regulation 10 of the principal regulations, as amended by regulation 4 of the Poultry Board Regulations 1949, Amerdment No. 1, is hereby further amended by omitting the words "£600 per annum", and substituting the words "£650 per annum".
- 4. Regulation 4 of the Poultry Board Regulations 1949, Amendment No. 1, is hereby consequentially revoked.
