PURSUANT to the Poultry Runs Registration Act, 1933, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Poultry Board Regulations 1949, Amendment No. 2.
2. These regulations shall be read together with and deemed part of the Poultry Board Regulations 1949* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).
3. Regulation 10 of the principal regulations, as amended by regulation 4 of the Poultry Board Regulations 1949, Amendment No. 1, is hereby further amended by omitting the words "£600 per annum", and substituting the words "£650 per annum".
4. Regulation 4 of the Poultry Board Regulations 1949, Amendment No. 1, is hereby consequentially revoked.
