HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Economic Stabilisation Act 1948, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Professional Charges (Price Freeze) Regulations 1976, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Professional Charges (Price Freeze) Regulations 1976\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

**2. Principal regulations continued in force**—Regulation 2 (2) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the word “May”, and substituting the word “August”.
