**THE PAPER (NEWSPRINT) CONTROL NOTICE 1941.**

PURSUANT to the powers vested in me by Regulation 5 of the Factory Emergency Regulations 1939, I, George Augustus Pascoe, Factory Controller, hereby give notice and direct as follows:—

1. This notice may be cited as the Paper (Newsprint) Control Notice 1941.

2. On and after the date of publication of this notice, paper (including newsprint) shall not be used by the occupier of a factory or an owner of factory materials without the express approval of the Factory Controller:—

- (a) For the purpose of printing or publishing any newspaper or magazine or other periodical that was not published during the period of thirteen months ended immediately before the date of this notice:
- (b) For the publication of any newspaper or magazine or other periodical after the date of this notice at more frequent intervals than the shortest intervals at which it was being published during the twelve months ended immediately prior to the date of this order.
