REGULATIONS

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Patents (Patent Cooperation Treaty) Amendment Regulations 1999, and are part of the Patents (Patent Cooperation Treaty) Regulations 1992\* (“the principal regulations”).

(2) These regulations come into force on 1 July 1999.

**2. New scale of fees substituted**—The principal regulations are amended by revoking the Schedule, and substituting the Schedule set out in the Schedule of these regulations.
