THE PATENTS, DESIGNS, AND TRADE-MARKS AND COPYRIGHT (HOURS OF INSPECTION) REGULATIONS, 1936.

Enacting authority : His Excellency the Governor-General in Council.

Acts pursuant to which the regulations were made : Section 138 of the Patents, Designs, and Trade-marks Act, 1921-22, section 53 of the Copyright Act, 1913, and all other powers and authorities enabling in that behalf.

Date on which the regulations were made : 9th day of December, 1936.

Date of notification in *Gazette* : 10th day of December, 1936.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Patents, Designs, and Trade-marks and Copyright (Hours of Inspection) Regulations, 1936.

2. These regulations shall come into force on the 9th day of December, 1936.

3. The respective regulations referred to in the Schedule hereto are amended by revoking the respective clauses the numbers of which are set out in the first column of the said Schedule, and by substituting for each of the respective revoked clauses the following clause :—

“ The office shall be open to the public every week-day except Saturday between the hours of 9 a.m. and noon and 2 p.m. and 4 p.m., except the days following :—

“ The days from Good Friday to Easter Tuesday, both inclusive ; the days from Christmas Eve to the 3rd January, both inclusive ; and any other day observed by the Government as a public holiday.”
