PURSUANT to section 54 of the Patents, Designs, and Trade-marks Amendment Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby order and declare as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Patents, Designs, and Trademarks Convention Order 1940, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Patents, Designs, and Trademarks Convention Order 1940* (hereinafter referred to as the principal Order).

2. The principal Order is hereby amended by omitting from clause 4 the words "The Union of South Africa".

3. Part A of the First Schedule of the principal Order is hereby amended by inserting, after the words "Spain, the Spanish Zone of Morocco", the words "the Spanish colonies"; and by inserting, after the word "Turkey", the words "Union of South Africa".
