Present :

THE HON. S. G. HOLLAND PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 54 of the Patents, Designs, and Trade-marks Amendment Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby order and declare as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Patents, Designs, and Trade-marks Convention Order 1940, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Patents, Designs, and Trade-marks Convention Order 1940\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal Order).

2. The principal Order is hereby amended by omitting from clause 4 the words "The Union of South Africa".

3. Part A of the First Schedule of the principal Order is hereby amended by inserting, after the words "Spain, the Spanish Zone of Morocco", the words "the Spanish colonies"; and by inserting, after the word "Turkey", the words "Union of South Africa".
