ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 14th day of September  
1960

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 77 of the Patents Act 1953, section 20 of the Designs Act 1953, and section 72 of the Trade Marks Act 1953, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby orders and declares as follows.

ORDER

1. This order may be cited as the Patents, Designs, and Trade Marks Convention Order 1940, Amendment No. 5, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Patents, Designs, and Trade Marks Convention Order 1940\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

2. Part A of the First Schedule to the principal order, as heretofore amended, is hereby further amended—

- (a) By inserting, after the word “Nauru”, the words “Federation of Rhodesia and Nyasaland”:
- (b) By inserting, after the word “Hungary”, the words “Iran” and “Republic of Ireland”:
- (c) By inserting, after the word “Greece”, the word “Haiti”:
- (d) By inserting, after the word “Mexico”, the word “Monaco”:
- (e) By inserting, after the word “Madeira”, the words “San Marino”:
- (f) By inserting, after the words “United States of America”, the word “Vietnam”.

3. Part B of the First Schedule to the principal order is hereby amended by omitting the word “Eire”.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

By this amendment, the Federation of Rhodesia and Nyasaland, Haiti, Monaco, Vietnam, Iran, and San Marino are included in the list of convention countries for the purposes of all the provisions of the Patents Act 1953, the Designs Act 1953, and the Trade Marks Act 1953, and the Republic of Ireland is transferred to that list.
