Pursuant to section 77 of the Patents Act 1953, section 20 of the Designs Act 1953, and section 72 of the Trade Marks Act 1953, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby orders and declares as follows.

ORDER

1. This order may be cited as the Patents, Designs, and Trade Marks Convention Order 1940, Amendment No. 7, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Patents, Designs, and Trade Marks Convention Order 1940* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

2. Part A of the First Schedule to the principal order, as heretofore amended, is hereby further amended by inserting between the words "Hungary" and "Iran", the word "Iceland".
