- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Periodic Detention Centre (Matthews Avenue (Kaitaia)) Notice 1999.
 - (2) This notice takes effect from 29 July 1999.
- 2. Matthews Avenue (Kaitaia) Periodic Detention Centre—The land described in the Schedule is a periodic detention centre to be known as the Matthews Avenue (Kaitaia) Periodic Detention Centre.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This notice, which takes effect from 29 July 1999, is made under the Criminal Justice Act 1985. It declares the land described in the Schedule to be a periodic detention centre to be known as the Matthews Avenue (Kaitaia) Periodic Detention Centre.

The Centre was previously known as the Kaitaia Periodic Detention Centre. The notice that constituted the Kaitaia Periodic Detention Centre, and a spent notice, are revoked by this notice.
