NOTICE

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This notice may be cited as the Periodic Detention Centre (King Edward Street (Dunedin)) Notice 1999.

(2) This notice takes effect from 14 January 1999.

**2. King Edward Street (Dunedin) Periodic Detention Centre**—The land described in the Schedule is a periodic detention centre to be known as the King Edward Street (Dunedin) Periodic Detention Centre.

**3. Revocation**—The Periodic Detention Centre (Percy Street (Dunedin)) Notice 1998\* is revoked.

## KING EDWARD STREET (DUNEDIN) PERIODIC DETENTION CENTRE

All that parcel of land in the Otago Land District containing 1670 square metres, more or less, being Lot 3 and part Lot 2 on Deposited Plan 7 and being part Section 12 Block VII Town District, and being all the land comprised and described in certificate of title No. 15B/186, Otago Registry.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This notice, which takes effect from 14 January 1999, is made under the Criminal Justice Act 1985. It declares the land described in the Schedule to be a periodic detention centre to be known as the King Edward Street (Dunedin) Periodic Detention Centre.

The Centre replaces the Percy Street (Dunedin) Periodic Detention Centre. The notice that constituted the Percy Street (Dunedin) Periodic Detention Centre is revoked by this notice.
