NOTICE

1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Periodic Detention Centre (Pages Road (Christchurch)) Notice 1998.

(2) This notice takes effect from 26 November 1998.

2. Pages Road (Christchurch) Periodic Detention Centre—The land described in the Schedule is a periodic detention centre to be known as the Pages Road (Christchurch) Periodic Detention Centre.

3. Revocation—The Work Centre (Pages Road) Notice 1987* is revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This notice, which takes effect from 26 November 1998, is made under the Criminal Justice Act 1985. It declares the land described in the Schedule to be a periodic detention centre, to be known as the Pages Road (Christchurch) Periodic Detention Centre.

The Centre is the same centre previously known as the Pages Road Work Centre and deemed to be a periodic detention centre by section 47(6) of the Criminal Justice Amendment Act 1993. The notice that constituted the Pages Road Work Centre is revoked by this notice.
