NOTICE

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Periodic Detention Centre (Hokianga Road (Dargaville)) Notice 1999.
 - (2) This notice takes effect from 16 July 1999.
- **2.** Hokianga Road (Dargaville) Periodic Detention Centre—The land described in the Schedule is a periodic detention centre, to be known as the Hokianga Road (Dargaville) Periodic Detention Centre.
- **3. Consequential revocation**—The Reporting Centre (Poto Avenue) Notice 1979* is revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This notice, which takes effect from 16 July 1999, declares the Dargaville Courthouse to be a periodic detention centre (to be known as the Hokianga Road (Dargaville) Periodic Detention Centre). It was originally declared to be a reporting centre for the Poto Avenue Work Centres, but since 1993 has been deemed by section 46 (6) of the Criminal Justice Amendment Act 1993 to be a periodic detention centre.
