NOTICE

1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Periodic Detention Centre (Jellicoe Road (Panmure)) Notice 1999.

(2) This notice takes effect from 23 August 1999.

2. Jellicoe Road (Panmure) Periodic Detention Centre—The land described in the Schedule is a periodic detention centre to be known as the Jellicoe Road (Panmure) Periodic Detention Centre.

3. Revocation—The Periodic Detention Centre (Tamaki Station Road (Panmure)) Notice 1998* is revoked.

All that parcel of land in the North Auckland Land District containing 2014 square metres, more or less, being part Allotment 31, Section 3, Small Lots near Panmure, and being all the land comprised and described in certificate of title No. 88C/866, North Auckland Registry.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This notice, which takes effect from 23 August 1999, is made under the Criminal Justice Act 1985. It declares the land described in the Schedule to be a periodic detention centre to be known as the Jellicoe Road (Panmure) Periodic Detention Centre.

The Centre was previously known as the Tamaki Station Road (Panmure) Periodic Detention Centre, but Tamaki Station Road is, from 23 August 1999, to be renamed Jellicoe Road. The notice that constituted the Tamaki Station Road (Panmure) Periodic Detention Centre is revoked by this notice.
