PURSUANT to section 126 of the Criminal Justice Act 1985, the Minister of Corrections gives the following notice.

NOTICE

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Periodic Detention Centre (Kenny Street (Waihi)) Notice 1999.
 - (2) This notice takes effect from 16 July 1999.
- **2. Kenny Street (Waihi) Periodic Detention Centre**—The land described in the Schedule is a Periodic Detention Centre, to be known as the Kenny Street (Waihi) Periodic Detention Centre.

SCHEDULE

KENNY STREET (WAIHI) PERIODIC DETENTION CENTRE

All the parcel of land in the South Auckland Land District containing 1727 square metres, more or less, situated in Block XV, Ohinemuri Survey District, being Section 2 on Survey Office Plan 58615, and being all the land comprised and described in Certificate of Title 51C/75 (South Auckland Registry).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This notice, which takes effect from 16 July 1999, declares the Waihi Courthouse to be a periodic detention centre (to be known as the Kenny Street (Waihi) Periodic Detention Centre). It was originally declared to be a reporting centre for the Wood Street Work Centres, but since 1993 has been deemed by section 46 (6) of the Criminal Justice Act 1993 to be a periodic detention centre.
