NOTICE

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This notice may be cited as the Periodic Detention Centre (Queen Street (Thames)) Notice 1999.

(2) This notice takes effect from 16 July 1999.

**2. Queen Street (Thames) Periodic Detention Centre**—The land described in the Schedule is a Periodic Detention Centre, to be known as the Queen Street (Thames) Periodic Detention Centre.

**3. Revocation**—The Reporting Centres Notice 1986\* is revoked.

SCHEDULE

QUEEN STREET (THAMES) PERIODIC DETENTION CENTRE

First, all the parcel of land in the South Auckland Land District containing 25 square metres, more or less, situated in Block IV, Thames Survey District, being part Thames Foreshore shown on Deposited Plan 910, and being all the land comprised and described in Certificate of Title 51C/330 (South Auckland Registry).

Secondly, all the parcel of land in the South Auckland Land District containing 1821 square metres, more or less, situated in Block IV, Thames Survey District, being part Te Karaka Block and part Tapuae Block, and being all the land comprised and described in Certificate of Title 51C/331 (South Auckland Registry).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This notice, which takes effect from 16 July 1999, declares the Thames Courthouse to be a periodic detention centre (to be known as the Queen Street (Thames) Periodic Detention Centre). It was originally declared to be a reporting centre for the Wood Street Work Centres, but since 1993 has been deemed by section 46 (6) of the Criminal Justice Act 1993 to be a periodic detention centre.

The notice also revokes the notice establishing the centre, and centres at Waihi, Morrinsville, and Putaruru, as reporting centres.
