PURSUANT to section 126 of the Criminal Justice Act 1985, the Minister of Corrections gives the following notice.

NOTICE

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Periodic Detention Centre (Gordon Street (Dannevirke)) Notice 1999.
 - (2) This notice takes effect from 16 July 1999.
- 2. Gordon Street (Dannevirke) Periodic Detention Centre-The land described in the Schedule is a Periodic Detention Centre, to be known as the Gordon Street (Dannevirke) Periodic Detention Centre.
- 3. Consequential revocation—The First Schedule of the Reporting Centres Notice 1988* is revoked.
- 4. Revocation of spent provisions—Clause 3 and the Fourth Schedule of the Reporting Centres Notice 1988 are revoked.

SCHEDULE

GORDON STREET (DANNEVIRKE) PERIODIC DETENTION CENTRE

All the parcel of land in the Hawke's Bay Land District containing 1720 square metres, more or less, situated in Block III, Tahoraiti Survey District, being Lots 6 and 7 Deposited Plan 932, Part Lot 13 Deposited Plan 284, and Part Lot 1 Deposited Plan 3491, and being all the land comprised and described in Certificate of Title P4/508 (Hawke's Bay Registry).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This notice, which takes effect from 16 July 1999, declares the Dannevirke Courthouse to be a periodic detention centre (to be known as the Gordon Street (Dannevirke) Periodic Detention Centre). It was originally declared to be a reporting centre for the David Street Work Centres, but since 1993 has been deemed by section 46 (6) of the Criminal Justice Act 1993 to be a periodic detention centre.
