PURSUANT to section 126 of the Criminal Justice Act 1985, the Minister of Corrections gives the following notice.

NOTICE

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Periodic Detention Centre (Killarney Street (Kaikoura)) Notice 1999.
 - (2) This notice takes effect from 16 July 1999.
- 2. Killarney Street (Kaikoura) Periodic Detention Centre—The land described in the Schedule is a Periodic Detention Centre, to be known as the Killarney Street (Kaikoura) Periodic Detention Centre.
- **3. Consequential revocation**—The Reporting Centres Notice 1989* is revoked.

SCHEDULE

KILLARNEY STREET (KAIKOURA) PERIODIC DETENTION CENTRE

All the parcel of land in the Marlborough Land District containing 980 square metres, more or less, being Section 488, Town of Kaikoura, and being all the land comprised and described in Certificate of Title 5A/1161 (Marlborough Registry).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This notice, which takes effect from 16 July 1999, declares the Kaikoura Courthouse to be a periodic detention centre (to be known as the Killarney Street (Kaikoura) Periodic Detention Centre). It was originally declared to be a reporting centre for the Wilson Street Work Centre, but since 1993 has been deemed by section 46 (6) of the Criminal Justice Act 1993 to be a periodic detention centre.
