NOTICE.

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Periodic Detention Centre (Tristram Street (Hamilton)) Notice 1999.
 - (2) This notice takes effect from 15 April 1999.
- **2. Tristram Street (Hamilton) Periodic Detention Centre**—The land described in the Schedule is a periodic detention centre to be known as the Tristram Street (Hamilton) Periodic Detention Centre.
- **3. Revocation**—The Periodic Detention Centre (Myrtle Street (Hamilton)) Notice 1998* is revoked.

SCHEDULE

TRISTRAM STREET (HAMILTON) PERIODIC DETENTION CENTRE

All that parcel of land in the South Auckland Land District containing 2391 square metres, more or less, being Lot 1 on Deposited Plan S28678, and being all the land comprised and described in certificate of title No. 66D/492, South Auckland Registry.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This notice, which takes effect from 15 April 1999, is made under the Criminal Justice Act 1985. It declares the land described in the Schedule to be a periodic detention centre to be known as the Tristram Street (Hamilton) Periodic Detention Centre.

The Centre replaces the Myrtle Street (Hamilton) Periodic Detention Centre. The notice that constituted the Myrtle Street (Hamilton) Periodic Detention Centre is revoked by this notice.
