NOTICE

1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Periodic Detention Centre (Moorhouse Street (Morrinsville)) Notice 1999.
(2) This notice takes effect from 16 July 1999.

2. Moorhouse Street (Morrinsville) Periodic Detention Centre—The land described in the Schedule is a Periodic Detention Centre, to be known as the Moorhouse Street (Morrinsville) Periodic Detention Centre.

SCHEDULE

MOORHOUSE STREET (MORRINSVILLE) PERIODIC DETENTION CENTRE

All the parcel of land in the South Auckland Land District containing 787 square metres, more or less, situated in Block VI, Maungakawa Survey District, being section 2 on Survey Office Plan 59450, and being all the land comprised and described in Certificate of Title 52D/318 (South Auckland Registry).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This notice, which takes effect from 16 July 1999, declares the Morrinsville Courthouse to be a periodic detention centre (to be known as the Moorhouse Street (Morrinsville) Periodic Detention Centre). It was originally declared to be a reporting centre for the Myrtle Street Work Centre, but since 1993 has been deemed by section 46 (6) of the Criminal Justice Act 1993 to be a periodic detention centre.
