**THE PERIODIC DETENTION ORDER (No. 2) 1965**

**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 11th day of October 1965

Present:

**THE RIGHT HON. KEITH HOLYOAKE, C.H., PRESIDING IN COUNCIL**

PURSUANT to section 2 of the Criminal Justice Amendment Act 1962, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

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**ORDER**

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Periodic Detention Order (No. 2) 1965.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 20th day of October 1965.

2. Section 9 and sections 11 to 15 of the Criminal Justice Amendment Act 1962 shall apply with respect to male offenders—

(a) Who are convicted after the commencement of this order in the Supreme Court at Invercargill or by a Magistrate's Court held at Invercargill or a Magistrate's Court held at Bluff or a Magistrate's Court held at Gore; or

(b) Against whom a charge is proved after the commencement of this order in a Children's Court held at Invercargill or a Children's Court held at Bluff or a Children's Court held at Gore.

3. Sections 10 to 15 of the said Act shall apply with respect to male offenders in respect of whom a warrant of commitment may be issued after the commencement of this order by a Magistrate exercising jurisdiction in a Magistrate's Court at Invercargill or a Magistrate's Court at Bluff or a Magistrate's Court at Gore in respect of a fine imposed on or after the 15th day of July 1963.
