**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government House at Wellington this 8th day of July 1974

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 2 of the Criminal Justice Amendment Act 1962, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

**ORDER**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This order may be cited as the Periodic Detention Order (No. 3) 1974.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 12th day of July 1974.

**2. Hawera and Stratford**—(1) Section 9 and sections 11 to 15 of the Criminal Justice Amendment Act 1962 shall apply with respect to male offenders who are of or over the age of 16 years and—

(a) Who are convicted after the commencement of this order by a Magistrate's Court held at Hawera or Stratford; or

(b) Against whom a charge is proved after the commencement of this order in a Children's Court held at Hawera or Stratford.

(2) Sections 10 to 15 of the said Act shall apply with respect to male offenders who are of or over the age of 16 years and in respect of whom a warrant of commitment may be issued after the commencement of this order by a Magistrate exercising jurisdiction in a Magistrate's Court held at Hawera or Stratford in respect of a fine imposed on or after the 15th day of July 1963.
