THE POPULATION ESTIMATES EMERGENCY REGULATIONS 1942

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government Buildings at Wellington, this 22nd day of April, 1942.

Present:

THE RIGHT HON. P. FRASER PRESIDING IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Population Estimates Emergency Regulations 1942.

2. Where in any Act population is a factor to be taken into account in deciding representation of local districts on a local or public body, or in allocating public moneys among local authorities or districts, or in deciding contributions by or levies on local authorities or districts for a common object or purpose, it shall be sufficient compliance with such Act if the population taken into account is as estimated by the Government Statistician for the 1st day of April, 1941.

3. Where subsequently to the 1st day of April, 1941, any alteration has been made in the boundaries of a local district which in the opinion of the Government Statistician results in an alteration in the number of the population thereof, then the estimate made as provided by the last preceding regulation shall be adjusted by the addition or subtraction of such a figure as in the opinion of the Government Statistician will cause the population of the local district to be stated as at any relevant date with as much accuracy as can be obtained with the information available.

4. The Government Statistician is hereby relieved of any obligation, express or implied, to furnish any certificate or estimate of population of any local district or districts for any date later than the 1st day of April, 1941. 5. These regulations shall cease to have any effect on the expiration of a period of three months after the taking of the next population census under the Census and Statistics Act, 1926.

6. These regulations shall have no application for the purposes of paragraph (c) of section 3 of the Municipal Corporations Act, 1933, or section 134 of the same Act, or section 3 of the Town Boards Amendment Act, 1908.*
