REGULATIONS.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Photography Emergency Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Photography Emergency Regulations 1939* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- 2. Regulation 3 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words "an officer of His Majesty's Forces", and substituting the words "any person".
