ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington, this 27th day of October, 1943

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 14 of the Police Force Act, 1913, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Police Force Amendment Regulations 1943, and shall be read together with and form part of the regulations made under the Police Force Act, 1913, on the 15th day of September, 1919* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of November, 1943.

3. Regulation 488 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words "shall not engage in trade of any kind, either by themselves or through their wives", and substituting the words "shall not without the permission in writing of the Commissioner, which permission may at any time be withdrawn, engage in business or trade of any kind either by themselves or through their wives or accept or engage in any remunerative employment other than that connected with the duties of their office".

4. Regulation 489 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by inserting, after the word "If", the words "without the permission in writing of the Commissioner"; and, after the word "business", the words "or trade or accepts or engages in any remunerative employment".
