**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At Wellington this 29th day of June 1990

Present:

THE RIGHT HON. HELEN CLARK PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 5 of the Public Finance Act 1989, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

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**ORDER**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This order may be cited as the Public Finance (Transfers Between Outputs) Order 1990.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 30th day of June 1990.

**2. Vote: Forestry**—It is hereby directed that \$167,000 of the amount appropriated in Vote: Forestry for the year ending on the 30th day of June 1990 for the class of outputs called Output II—Improved Forest Growing Technologies be transferred to the class of outputs in that Vote called Output III—Improved Harvesting Technologies.

**3. Vote: Ministry of Education**—(1) It is hereby directed that the amounts specified in subclause (2) of this clause, being amounts aggregating the sum of \$3,200,000 and being amounts appropriated in Vote: Ministry of Education for the year ending on the 30th day of June

1990 for the classes of outputs in that Vote that are specified in subclause (2) of this clause, be transferred to the class of outputs in that Vote called Output XII-Provision of School Transport.

(2) The classes of outputs from which, by subclause (1) of this clause, amounts are directed to be transferred and the amounts that, by that subclause, are directed to be transferred from each of those classes of outputs are as follows:

**4. Vote: Scientific and Industrial Research—**(1) It is hereby directed that the amounts specified in subclause (2) of this clause, being amounts aggregating the sum of \$2,931,000 and being amounts appropriated in Vote: Scientific and Industrial Research for the year ending on the 30th day of June 1990 for the classes of outputs in that Vote that are specified in subclause (2) of this clause, be transferred, in the amounts specified in subclause (3) of this clause, to the classes of outputs in that Vote that are specified in subclause (3) of this clause.

(2) The classes of outputs from which, by subclause (1) of this clause, amounts are directed to be transferred and the amounts that, by that subclause, are directed to be transferred from each of those classes of outputs are as follows:

**5. Vote: Environment—**(1) It is hereby directed that the amounts specified in subclause (2) of this clause, being amounts aggregating the sum of \$380,000 and being amounts appropriated in Vote: Environment for the year ending on the 30th day of June 1990 for the classes of outputs in that Vote that are specified in subclause (2) of this clause, be transferred, in the amounts specified in subclause (3) of this clause, to the classes of outputs in that Vote that are specified in subclause (3) of this clause.

(2) The classes of outputs from which, by subclause (1) of this clause, amounts are directed to be transferred and the amounts that, by that subclause, are directed to be transferred from each of those classes of outputs are as follows:

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EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order, which comes into force on 30 June 1990 and which is made under section 5 of the Public Finance Act 1989, directs that amounts appropriated for the year ending on 30 June 1990 for certain specified classes of outputs in the Vote: Forestry, the Vote: Ministry of Education, the Vote: Scientific and Industrial Research, and the Vote: Environment be transferred to another class of outputs in the Vote.

Section 5 of the Public Finance Act 1989 provides—

- (a) That the amount transferred must not increase an appropriation for a financial year for a class of outputs by more than 5 percent; and
- (b) That no other transfer to that class of outputs must have occurred during the financial year; and
- (c) That the total amount appropriated for the financial year for all classes of outputs in the Vote must be unaltered.
