

# THE PUBLIC FINANCE (TRANSFERS BETWEEN OUTPUTS) ORDER 1995

## ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 26th day of June 1995

### Present:

HER EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 5 of the Public Finance Act 1989, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

#### ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Public Finance (Transfers Between Outputs) Order 1995.
  - (2) This order shall come into force on the 30th day of June 1995.
- 2. Vote Agriculture—It is hereby directed that one hundred and seventy thousand dollars (\$170,000) of the amount appropriated in Vote Agriculture for the financial year ending on the 30th day of June 1995 for the class of outputs called Administration of Agricultural Security, Quality Assurance and Pest Management Strategies be transferred to the class of outputs in that Vote called Pest and Disease Emergency Response Services.
  - **8. Vote Conservation**—It is hereby directed that—
  - (a) Fifty-six thousand dollars (\$56,000) of the amount appropriated in Vote Conservation for the financial year ending on the 30th day

of June 1995 for the class of outputs called Policy Advice and Ministerial Servicing; and

(b) Fifty-six thousand dollars (\$56,000) of the amount appropriated in Vote Conservation for the financial year ending on the 30th day of June 1995 for the class of outputs called Implementation of Legal Protection; and

(c) One hundred and thirteen thousand dollars (\$113,000) of the amount appropriated in Vote Conservation for the financial year ending on the 30th day of June 1995 for the class of outputs called Management of Statutory Actions, Leases, Licences and Other Concessions,—

be transferred to the class of outputs in that Vote called Provision of Recreation Opportunities: Access, Facilities and Services.

**4. Revocation**—The Public Finance (Transfer Between Outputs) Order 1992\* is hereby revoked.

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force on 30 June 1995 and which is made under section 5 of the Public Finance Act 1989, directs—

- (a) That \$170,000 of the amount appropriated in Vote Agriculture for the financial year ending 30 June 1995 for the class of outputs called Administration of Agricultural Security, Quality Assurance and Pest Management Strategies be transferred to the class of outputs in that Vote called Pest and Disease Emergency Response Services; and
- (b) That \$225,000 of the amount appropriated in Vote Conservation for the financial year ending 30 June 1995 be transferred from three separate classes of outputs in that Vote to the class of outputs in that Vote called Provision of Recreation Opportunities: Access, Facilities and Services.

Section 5 of the Public Finance Act 1989 provides-

- (a) That the amount transferred must not increase an appropriation for a financial year for a class of outputs by more than 5 percent; and
- (b) That no other transfer under that section to that class of outputs must have occurred during the financial year; and
- (c) That the total amount appropriated for the financial year for all classes of outputs in the Vote must be unaltered.

An order, which is now spent but which was made under that section in respect of the financial year ending on 30 June 1992, is revoked.
