1997**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 23rd day of June 1997

PURSUANT to section 5 of the Public Finance Act 1989, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, makes the following order.

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ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Public Finance (Transfers Between Outputs) Order 1997.

(2) This order comes into force on 27 June 1997.

2. Vote Education—It is directed that one hundred and twenty thousand dollars (\$120,000) of the amount appropriated in Vote Education for the financial year ending on 30 June 1997 for the class of outputs called O13 Training for Designated Groups be transferred to the class of outputs in that Vote called O4 School Transport.

3. Vote Education Review—(1) It is directed that—

- (a) Thirty-four thousand dollars (\$34,000) of the amount appropriated in Vote Education Review for the financial year ending on 30 June 1997 for the class of outputs called D1 Accountability Reporting; and
- (b) Ninety-seven thousand dollars (\$97,000) of the amount appropriated in Vote Education Review for the financial year ending on 30 June 1997 for the class of outputs called D3 Evaluation Services—

be transferred to the class of outputs in that Vote called D2 Effectiveness Reporting.

4. Vote Revenue—(1) It is directed that the amounts specified in subclause (2), being amounts appropriated in Vote Revenue for the financial year ending on 30 June 1997 for the classes of outputs in that Vote that are specified in subclause (2), be transferred, in the amounts specified in subclause (3), to the classes of outputs in that Vote that are specified in subclause (3).

(2) The classes of outputs from which, by subclause (1), amounts are directed to be transferred and the amounts that, by that subclause, are directed to be transferred from each of those classes of outputs are as follows:

(3) The classes of outputs to which, by subclause (1), amounts are directed to be transferred and the amounts that, by that subclause, are directed to be transferred to each of those classes of outputs are as follows:

5. Vote Statistics—It is directed that one million three hundred and fifty thousand dollars (\$1,350,000) of the amount appropriated in Vote Statistics for the financial year ending on 30 June 1997 for the class of outputs called D3 Economic and Business Statistical Information Services be transferred to the class of outputs in that Vote called D2 Population, Social and Labour Force Statistical Information Services.

6. Revocation—The Public Finance (Transfer Between Outputs) Order 1996* is revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force on 27 June 1997, is made under section 5 of the Public Finance Act 1989. That section authorises the Governor-General by Order in Council to direct that an amount appropriated in a Vote for a specified class of outputs be transferred to another class of outputs in that Vote where—

- (a) The amount transferred does not increase an appropriation for a financial year for a class of outputs by more than 5 percent; and
- (b) No other transfer under that section to that class of outputs has occurred during that financial year; and
- (c) The total amount appropriated for that financial year for all classes of outputs in that Vote is unaltered.

This order directs that—

- (a) The sum of \$120,000 be transferred from the amounts appropriated for one class of outputs in Vote Education for the financial year ending 30 June 1997 to another class of outputs in that Vote;
- (b) A total of \$131,000 be transferred from the amounts appropriated for two classes of outputs in Vote Education Review for the financial year ending 30 June 1997 to another class of outputs in that Vote;
- (c) A total of \$2,025,000 be transferred from the amounts appropriated for two classes of outputs in Vote Revenue for the financial year ending 30 June 1997 to four other classes of outputs in that Vote;
- (d) The sum of \$1,350,000 be transferred from the amount appropriated for one class of outputs in Vote Statistics for the financial year ending 30 June 1997 to another class of outputs in that Vote.

An order, which is now spent, but which was made under section 5 of the Public Finance Act 1989 in respect of the financial year ending on 30 June 1996, is revoked.
