**THE PHOSPHATIC FERTILIZER CONTROL NOTICE 1941,
AMENDMENT NO. 1.**

PURSUANT to the Primary Industries Emergency Regulations 1939, I, Alfred Hyde Cockayne, Primary Industries Controller, do hereby give notice as follows :—

1. This notice may be cited as the Phosphatic Fertilizer Control Notice 1941, Amendment No. 1.

2. This notice shall be read together with and form part of the Phosphatic Fertilizer Control Notice 1941* (hereinafter called the principal notice).

3. This notice shall come into force on the day of publication hereof in the *Gazette*.

4. The Second Schedule to the principal notice is revoked, and the following Schedule substituted :—
