ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 12th day of March, 1941.

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

Pursuant to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations:—

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Police Force Emergency Regulations 1941.
- 2. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in section 15 of the Police Force Act, 1913,* no person employed in the Police Force of New Zealand may resign his office unless expressly authorized in writing so to do by the Minister in Charge of the Police Force.
- 3. Any such person who resigns his office without having obtained such authority from the Minister shall be liable to the penalties specified in subsection (2) of the said section 15.
