THE POLICE FORCE PAY REGULATIONS 1950

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington, this 30th day of
June, 1950

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Police Force Act, 1947, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Police Force Pay Regulations 1950.
 2. The rates of pay and allowances payable to members of the Police Force shall be those set out in the First Schedule hereto.
 3. Payments at the rates aforesaid shall be made in respect of service rendered on and after the 1st day of June, 1949.
 4. Except as therein otherwise stated, the rates set out in the said First Schedule are annual rates.
 5. Where a member of the Force of any rank is provided free of charge in respect of his employment with lodging for himself or his family or with the use of a house or is under the authority of these regulations paid an allowance instead of being so provided with lodging or with the use of a house, then, notwithstanding any other provision of these regulations, the annual value of those benefits for the purposes of section 55 of the Superannuation Act, 1947, is hereby declared to be the appropriate sum set out in the Second Schedule hereto.
