**THE POLICE FORCE PAY REGULATIONS 1955,
AMENDMENT NO. 1**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 28th day of September 1955

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Police Force Act 1947, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Police Force Pay Regulations 1955, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Police Force Pay Regulations 1955* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall be deemed to have come into force on the 18th day of November 1954.

2. (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of regulation 3 of the principal regulations, the rates of allowances per annum in place of overtime payable to members of the Police Force in respect of the period commencing on the 18th day of November 1954 and ending on the 31st day of July 1955 shall be those set out in the First Schedule hereto.

(2) The rates of pay and allowances payable to members of the Police Force after the 31st day of July 1955 shall be those set out in the Second Schedule hereto.

3. Where any member of the Force serving as a radio technician is appointed or promoted to any grade of any rank, he shall be entitled to the pay and allowances appropriate to that grade notwithstanding that he has not served the period of time indicated in the Second Schedule hereto as appropriate to that grade.

4. The principal regulations shall be deemed to be amended, as from the 1st day of August 1955, by revoking regulations 3 and 4 thereof and the Second Schedule thereto.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

[*This note is not part of the regulation, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*]

These regulations prescribe the rates of pay for members of the Police Force.

The allowances formerly made instead of overtime are now amalgamated with annual salaries.

Issued under the authority of the Regulations Act 1936.

Date of notification in *Gazette*: 29 September 1955.

These regulations are administered in the Police Department.
