## THE POLICE FORCE REGULATIONS 1950, AMENDMENT NO. 1

At the Government Buildings at Wellington, this 6th day of February, 1951

#### Present:

THE HON. K. J. HOLYOAKE PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Police Force Act, 1947, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

#### REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Police Force Regulations 1950, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Police Force Regulations 1950\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day following

the date of their notification in the Gazette.

2. The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking

Regulation 80, and substituting the following regulation:

- "80. (1) Any member of the Force who, not having completed forty years' service as a member of the Force or as a contributor to the Government Superannuation Fund, is retiring from the Force on account of age or medical unfitness may, if his conduct has been satisfactory, be granted three months' leave of absence on full pay before his retirement.
- "(2) Any member of the Force who retires from the Force after completing not less than forty years' service as a member of the Force or as a contributor to the Government Superannuation Fund may be granted leave of absence on full pay for a period not exceeding six months, or an allowance not exceeding the amount of three months' salary instead thereof.
- "(3) If a member of the Force about to retire from the Force occupies a house provided by the Police Department, he shall vacate that house on or before the date of the commencement of any leave of absence granted to him under this regulation."

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

[This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.]

These regulations provide for an extension of the retiring leave of a member of the Police Force on the completion of forty years' service as a member of the Force or as a contributor to the Government Superannuation Fund.
