



THE PRICE FREEZE REGULATIONS 1974, AMENDMENT NO. 6

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 29th day of May 1978

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Economic Stabilisation Act 1948, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Price Freeze Regulations 1974, Amendment No. 6, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Price Freeze Regulations 1974* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Interpretation—Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by inserting, after the definition of the term “fish”, the following definition:

“‘Frozen fish’ means fish that for one continuous period from the time of preparation for retail sale has been maintained at a temperature below -12°C and that, if to be sold in a frozen condition, has not before sale been refrozen after thawing.”

3. Prices increased—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the First, Second, and Eighth Schedules (as substituted by regulation 2 of the Price Freeze Regulations 1974, Amendment No. 5), and substituting the First, Second, and Eighth Schedules set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

3. The Tauranga District—

The city of Tauranga, the boroughs of Mount Maunganui, Murupara, Kawerau, and Te Puke, the county of Tauranga, and the District of Whakatane.

4. The Coromandel/Thames District—

The boroughs of Paeroa and Waihi and the District of Thames Coromandel.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

“Frozen fish”, which is exempt from the regulations, is defined to include fish frozen to -12°C and is sold in that frozen form.

The regulations also increase the maximum prices for fish sold in the districts defined in the Schedules to these regulations. For the purpose of effecting the increase new First, Second, and Eighth Schedules to the principal regulations are substituted. Some minor changes have been made in the categories of fish to which the regulations apply. The districts within which the principal regulations apply remain the same apart from changes required because of local authority amalgamations or changes in the boundaries of districts of local authorities.
